When you do require printing them out we recommend using both sides of the paper if the document or form is more than 1 page.

Please always use recycled paper when printing our materials.

We value you as a Member and would respectfully ask that you take part in our policy.

As per Ontario Fire Code regulations 2 hard copies must be onsite at all times in case the AHJ requires them.

We will print out 2 hard copies in an environmentally friendly way and place it in an appropriate place on site to meet this code.

All other forms will be passed on via disk or e-mail in secure PDF or word document forms to save paper and inks.

We thank you in advance for your understanding and your help in this matter.
